## ALGONQUIN SPORTS COMPLEX DESIGN: CAST YOUR FINAL VOTE

In partnership with Eastern Central Florida Regional Planning Council (ECFRPC), the City of Indian Harbour Beach is excited to see how the community has responded to the plans to redevelop Algonquin Sports Complex. There has been a significant amount of feedback and ideas coming from residents of all ages. During the Arts & Craft Show last November, many residents came out and voted on six top park designs. Since then, ECFRPC was able to narrow those 6 down to the top three designs: 1. Sports and Activity design, 2. Family-Oriented design, and 3. Nature design. Recently, residents were invited to vote on their favorite of these three designs. The city received a good turnout as many residents came and gave their input, made suggestions and selected their park of choice.



To ensure that every resident has a chance to give their input on the new design of Algonquin, the City of Indian Harbour Beach is inviting the community to come out once again and cast a final vote on the top three park designs. Voting will take place at Gleason Park Recreation Center on Tuesday, April 5, 2022. There will be two time frames for voting; 9 a.m. – 11 a.m. and 4 p.m. – 6 p.m.

The City strongly encourages all residents to come out on April 5th and let their voices be heard one last time on this citizen-driven project!
