Follow-up Discussion and Direction on a Letter Concerning the Jamestown Condominium Exterior Building Structure Inspection Report

Motion made by Council Member Nolan to send to the Jamestown Homeowners' Association Board of Directors the updated letter from Building Official Wiles, seconded by Council Member Sharek – motion carried 5-0.

American Rescue Plan Act Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund Agreement

Motion made by Council Member Sharek to ratify the execution of the American Rescue Plan Act Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund Agreement that was signed by City Manager Ryan, seconded by Council Member Nolan – motion carried 5-0.

Brevard County Board of County Commissioners Letter of Support

Motion made by Council Member Sharek to submit a letter, signed by the Mayor, to the Florida Department of Transportation Secretary Kevin Thibault, supporting the installation of additional safety improvements as the mid-block crossings with Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFB), seconded by Deputy Mayor Panicola – motion carried 5-0.

Settlement Offer for Special Magistrate Cases #2018-07 and #2020-019

The outstanding fines on the two Special Magistrate cases is \$79,875.00 plus \$319.26 administrative costs for a total due of \$80,194.26. The respondent offered \$6,400.00.

Motion made by Deputy Mayor Panicola to make a counter offer of 10% of outstanding fines plus administrative costs, seconded by Council Member Guertin.

City Clerk Frank asked for clarification on the motion of whether it was 10% of fines plus administrative fees or 10% including administrative fees.

Deputy Mayor Panicola amended his motion to be a counter offer of 10% including administrative fees. Council Member Guertin accepted the amended motion. The amended motion carried 5-0.

The consensus of Council was that if the counter offer was accepted, the City would release the lien and accept the settlement proposal.
